### Organization overview:

Sekem	Sustainable development initiative, farming the desert ecologically and ethically. Production of sustainable and organic products.
Heliopolis University	Inaugurated in 2012, Heliopolis University is a non-profit university in Egypt with the mission of sustainable development.
Greenish	Egyptian social enterprise that aims to achieve sustainable development through interactive educational activities, environmental assessment services, and provide support to local vulnerable communities.
youththinkgreen	A non-for-profit social enterprise aiming to educate and empower youth to apply sustainable ecological solutions.
Upfuse	Cairo-based social enterprise, upcycling trash to bags, fashion and shoes, as well as teaching youth to upcycle.
FES	The Friedrich Ebert Foundation aims to promote democracy, and support economic and social development through various projects.
Banlastic	Alexandria-based social enterprise Banlastic aims to one day ban single-use plastic once and for all - they work advocacy through clean ups and workshops and have a financial stream for plastic alternatives.
Goethe-Institut	The GI provides access to German culture and language, and supports various projects adjent to those fields. They have been active in Egypt since 1958 and have offices in Cairo, Alexandria and Hurghada.
Kendaka	Is set up by women for women upcycling and crafting glass and textile waste into products for the Egyptian market.
